Which Darjeeling tea is right for me?

Here is some information that might help you to decide:

Green Darjeeling or Black Darjeeling?

Black tea and **green tea** are made from the same tea leaves. **Black Darjeeling** is a fermented tea; **Green Darjeeling** is an unfermented tea. To prevent fermentation, Green Darjeeling undergoes a process of steaming immediately after it is plucked.

Green Darjeeling Tea

Green Darjeeling has a mild, fresh taste. Unlike many other green teas, it does **not** taste like boiled grass. It is very popular because of its many benefits to health.

Black Darjeeling Tea

If you prefer a black tea, you have a choice between **Darjeeling First Flush** and **Darjeeling Second Flush**. They are of the same premium quality but differ in taste. "First" and "Second" refer to the time of harvest.

First Flush	Darjeeling tea from the first harvest after winter (leaves plucked between the end of February and April)	Light, flowery flavor	Bright liquor
Second Flush	Darjeeling tea from the second harvest after winter (leaves plucked from June till mid-July)	Fuller and stronger than First Flush	Amber-gold liquor

Darjeeling teas from later harvests in the year are of an inferior quality. Boston Tea Campaign does not offer these teas.

Darjeeling Garden Tea

Darjeeling tea that comes from one single, especially exclusive tea garden is called **Garden Tea**. Garden Teas can be First Flush or Second Flush. They are highly prized among tea connoisseurs.

FTGFOP 1

"Finest Tippy Golden Flowery Orange Pekoe 1"

All our Darjeeling teas, black and green, are **FTGFOP 1**. The term designates the very best leaf grade. It refers to tea of the highest quality, most carefully produced from even leaves and tender tips.
